

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
VILLAGE OF MEDINA**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that a Public Hearing will be held by the Village Board of the Village of Medina on August 24, 2020 at 7:05 p.m., at the Village of Medina Senior Center, 615 West Avenue, Medina, New York 14103, regarding the adoption of a proposed Local Law 3-2020, which would institute a sixty (60) day moratorium on murals and public art displays in the Village's Downtown Historic Preservation District, in order for the Village to review its laws, rules and regulations regarding murals and public art displays and to consider the creation of a Public Arts Commission and said Local Law is entitled "Moratorium on Public Art and Murals in the Downtown Historic Preservation District". An abstract of which is as follows:

A Local Law No. 3-2020, Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ (To be determined)

**Moratorium on Public Art and Murals in the Downtown Historic Preservation District**

1. Purpose and intent of this local law is to institute a sixty (60) day moratorium on murals and public art displays in the Village's Downtown Historic Preservation District, in order for the Village to review its laws, rules and regulations regarding murals and public art displays and to consider the creation of a Public Arts Commission. The moratorium is to enhance the ability of the Village to protect and promote the visual and aesthetic character of the Village of Medina.
2. A sixty (60) day moratorium shall hereby be instituted in the Village of Medina Downtown Historic District, preventing the erection or creation of any mural or public art displays. No such new murals or public art displays may be erected, created, completed and/or permitted during the pendency of said moratorium.
3. This local law shall take effect upon passage by the Village Board of Trustees.

The complete text of said law is on file in the office of the Village Clerk, and is available for review by any interested person during business hours.

At such Public Hearing, all persons interested who wish to be heard, will be heard. Please note that due to COVID-19 regulations and space limitations, pre-registration for attendance must be made at the Village Clerk's Office on a first come basis. The Village will also be accepting written comments for the record and review by the Village Board, to be sent to [publichearing@villagemedina.org](mailto:publichearing@villagemedina.org) , with the subject line "moratorium".
