#### SPRING

#### YES! Recycle:

- Nursery pots & cracked planters (empty)
- Buckets (empty)
- Plastic or metal patio furniture or folding chairs
- Plastic or metal kids furniture or large toys
- Metal lamps (bulbs removed)
- Gutters & downspouts (4 feet long or less)
- Clean metal or plastic paint trays
- Old homework, tests, notebooks, school papers

### **NO! Dispose:**

# Please DO NOT put these items in your recycle cart or bin any season:

- Hoses & rubber items like balls
- Light bulbs (in candescent & fluorescent bulbs & tubes)
- Wood waste
- Paint cans/paint
- Blow-up pools, pool liners, tarps or covers
- Items w/gasoline (lawn equipment)
- Plate glass, mirrors, dishes or ceramics
- Containers with hazardous materials or chemical residue (pool chemicals, engine oil, household cleaners, etc)
- Branches/Yard waste/Grass clippings

- Clothing, sheets and other textiles
- Electronics
- Metal hangers
- String lights
- Yard waste/grass clippings
